The Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting (AAPM) is *not* a meeting of the Parish Council. It is a meeting of the parish electors that takes place between the 1st of March and 1st of June. The legislation that establishes this meeting is in section 14 and 15 of the Local Government Act 1972.

What is Section 14 of the Local Government Act 1972?

(1)A parish council shall consist of the chairman and parish councillors and shall have all such functions as are vested in the council by this Act or otherwise. (2)The parish council shall be a body corporate by the name "The Parish Council" with the addition of the name of the particular parish.

What is Section 15 of the Local Government Act 1972?

(1)The chairman of a parish council shall be elected annually by the council from among the [F1elected] councillors.

AGENDA

1. The Chairperson of the Parish Council, any two Councillors or six electors may call the Annual Assembly. In this case, as the incoming chairperson has not been elected yet, the outgoing Chairperson will run proceedings and the handover to the new Parish Council Chairperson.
2. The standing electorate will have the option of co-opting members of the public to the council as there are current vacancies.
3. The District Councillor will be invited to share local activities and debate local issues.
4. Electors can contribute to the agenda and participate.

There will be some overlap with the agenda for the AGM and Full Council Meeting to be held after this meeting finishes.

If there are no electorates present, then after item 2. we shall formerly close the Annual Assembly and continue with the Parish AGM and Full Council Meeting.

Members of the public and press are welcome to attend.
