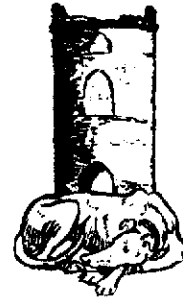

Clerk will forward all applications for the Clerk/RFO to the Parish Councillors who will organise to hire hall and arrange interviews.

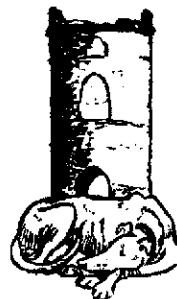
