

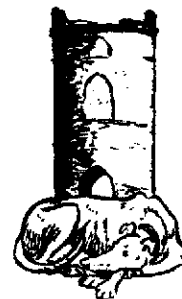

JP – concerns that the roads are dangerous roads, such as the potholes verges. He was reminded that all concerns should be reported through the WBC portal. He would also suggest that if the danger is not marked there should be a traffic cone. **JP** to write about it to clerk, who will refer to WBC portfolio councillor and District Councillor **MS**.
BW – village hall, Alan Maskell is stepping down as chairman and Karen Fontaine will take over. The Health & Safety aspects needs a review, including PAT and fire extinguishers. No legal document for hall users so that will need review. Volunteers day 8th March – 2 hanging baskets, clear up garden and fixed front fence. Hoping volunteer rota for each month. 21st March, quiz needs follow up. Flower show in May, wine tasking in June. Summer fair in village – question about water and electricity; historically not viable. Would need to consider use of generator and water in a carry . Asian Hornets test for 2 months – April and May
JD - Tidmarsh Lane traffic worse since Ashhampstead road closed. Write to Clerk to lobby WBC.
JP suggested that Tidmarsh Lane needs to be weighted.
JD – gift for Jon Chishick as a thank you for being the Chairman, now resigned – budget £35. **JD** will organise. Proposed **JD**, seconded **JP**

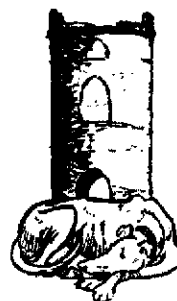

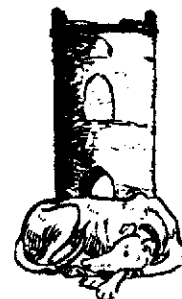
