

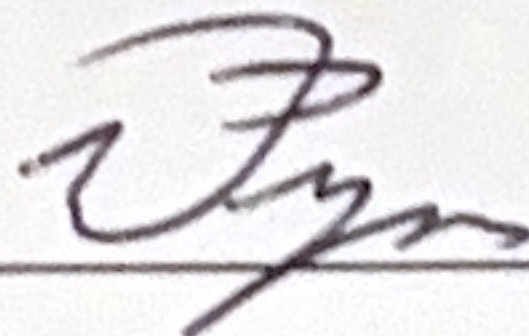

25/67	Quorum, Notice & Apologies for Absence A quorum was present and due notice of the Meeting had been served; no apologies had been received from Cllr Shakespeare and the Chairman welcomed the members of the public to the meeting.	
25/68	Declaration of Interests No new Declaration of Interests were received.	
25/69	Approval & signing of the Minutes of the Council Meeting held on Wednesday, 9th July 2025 The Minutes of the last Ordinary Meeting of 9 th July 2025 were presented for approval. Cllr Pearson questioned the accuracy of Minute item 25/59 (Updates & Presentation by James Austin, Tidmarsh with Sulham Flood Warden) in terms of the action on him, stating he did not remember agreeing to draft and send an appropriate letter to the EA following a meeting to be held between himself, Cllr Farrington, James Austin (the Flood Warden) and Mr. Smith to discuss and agree potential flooding defence measures on Mr. Smith's land. After some discussion, Cllr Pearson was asked if he would be willing to write such a letter and he confirmed he would be prepared to do so. A verbal altercation ensued. The Chairman in accordance with Standing Order 2 (a) asked a Councillor to moderate or improve their behaviour; the Councillor did not do so. The Chairman in accordance with Standing Order 2 (b) asked the Councillor to leave the meeting. The Councillor questioned the Chairman's authority, and as the Councillor did not agree to either moderate their behaviour or leave the meeting, and due to a subsequent intervention by a member of the public, the Chairman closed the meeting in line with the Standing Orders provision 2 (c).
